# MARK FINGER-HOOSIER MUSICIAN

Mark Finger was named "Hoosier Musician" by the Indiana Music Educators Association. This is the highest award given by IMEA. The award is designed to give recognition to an individual who has contributed to the advancement of music education in the state of Indiana and who has contributed outstanding service to local, state and national music organizations. Mark was cited for his lifelong commitment to music education in his role as a high school band director as well as his support to the music education program as a high school principal. He has continued his support by serving as the State Chair of Future Music Educators at the IMEA Conference for many years. This role was to help high school students considering the field of music education as a career and Mark provided leadership and thoughtful programming to these students. Mark also served as the State Chair for the high school Honor Band for IMEA for thirteen years and in this capacity served on the IMEA Board of Directors. He also served two terms on the Board of Directors of the Indiana State School Music Association as the Administrator Representative. Mark served as the chair for Music in the Statehouse. He has served as a facilitator for various seminars at Ball State, Butler, Anderson University and the University of Louisville. At the local level Mark was recognized for establishing and directing Alpha Brass, a music ministry of First United Methodist Church. He was recognized for his continued work in many other musical organizations including the church Sanctuary Choir, Wesley Chorale and Handbell Choir. He is also one of four founding members of the Directors jazz Orchestra, a community jazz band.
