Reminders of how important these ministries are!

- 1. Greeters and Ushers are ministers of hospitality.
- 2. Greeters and Ushers have a very public ministry which profoundly affects the quality of each worship experience.
- 3. Both roles play a vital role in the long-term health of the church. (Guests have the ability to detect lack of sincerity in the people they encounter. Newcomers decide in the first 5 minutes whether to return.)
- 4. Good hospitality does not simply happen it is prayed for, planned for, organized, evaluated and celebrated.
- 5. Greeters and Ushers (and Security Staff) need to be identified clearly Blue Vests are available on Sunday morning and all should wear a vest throughout the morning.
- 6. Greeters are the first members of the congregation that people meet upon arrival at church. Ushers are the first representative of Christ for a worship service.

#### **HELPING HANDS PANTRY**

We continue to be blessed by the generous donations of our congregation. At our September 11<sup>th</sup> Helping Hands Nonfood Pantry, with the help of our six volunteers, we were able to distribute needed supplies to 58 women and 37 men, for a total of 90 guests. The average number of quests we served over the last six months was 96. This month we gave each guest two large rolls of toilet paper, hand sanitizer, a toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant and a bottle of dish soap. Each quest was very appreciative of the items they received.

Our next Pantry is October 9, 2024 from 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM. Donations that would help us for that Pantry are toilet paper, liquid hand soap or a bar of soap, and shampoo. 
