#### \*LIGHTING THE ADVENT CANDLE OF HOPE

ONE: Today is the first Sunday in the season of

Advent. Advent means "coming," and in this season we prepare for the coming of Christ. We light the candle on the Advent wreath to remind

us of the blessings that Christ brings to the

world.

ONE: The Advent wreath includes many symbols. The

wreath is in the circle, with no beginning and no ending. This reminds us that there is no

beginning and no ending to God, and that God's

love and caring for us never ends.

The candles tell us of the light shining into the ONE: world with Jesus Christ. The white candle, which

we light on Christmas Eve, signifies the birth of

One purple candle is lit.
